Home Language, English Language Proficiency

- The HLS and English proficiency testing are required by state law (Calif. Ed. Code 52164.1a).
- Within 2 days of enrollment, schools must ensure:
 - Completion of the HLS
 - Referrals to RUSD Assessment Center (AC)

Here are the steps to follow:

1. HLS must be completed for each student enrolling.

- It only need be completed one time in a California public school.
- Parents/guardians must answer each of the 4 questions, sign/date the form.
- DO NOT COACH PARENTS ON HOW TO ANSWER THE QUESTIONS.
- Any cross outs require the completion of a new HLS.

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3. For a student verified as new to California public schools (K-12):

a. If the student has a language other than English for any of the HLS questions (even if in combination with English), go to **Step 4**.

- This is also a requirement for foreign exchange students who have a language other than English.

b. If the student has “English” as the only answer to all 4 language questions, follow **Steps 4 - 6**.

4. Contact the Assessment Center in these cases:

- a. A language "other than English," or in addition to English appears on lines 1, 2, 3, or 4 of the home language survey
- b. The student is found, in CALPADS, to have an "Acquisition Code" of EL, I-FEP or R-FEP
- c. The student is an English Learner (EL) student returning to RUSD
- d. A discrepancy exists between the language on the HLS and the primary language code in CALPADS

5. FAX or scan the completed RUSD Enrollment Form **and** HLS to the Assessment Center (FAX 951-274-4205 outside, or ext. 80881 internal) so the Assessment Center can set an appointment.

- a. The school site is responsible for informing the parent/guardian of the appointment information.
 - i. Use the most current AC Appointment Letter available on the Assessment Center "Power Learning" class.
 - ii. Provide a CELDT brochure to the parent (English on Pages 9-10, Spanish on Page 11-12).

- b. At the Assessment Center, the student takes the state's English proficiency test and an assessment in the primary language.
 - Results notification is provided to the site and parent/guardian.

- e. The site populates the CA School Entry Date for all newly-enrolling English-Only (EO) or American Sign Language students.

- f. Assessment Center populates Language Fluency, EL Levels, all other data in Language Assessment.

7. The HLS asks in which language parent/guardian would like to have school-related correspondence sent. That language should be entered in the Correspondence Language ("CorrLng") field in the Student Demographics table.

6. DATA ENTRY BY SCHOOL SITES

- Unless previously populated, the site populates the answers to all four home language questions in the Language Assessment table, “Home Language Survey” area.

- Place the original HLS in the student’s permanent record.
 - c. If already populated, **do not** change the language codes.
 - d. If the HLS has another language in combination with English for any of the answers (no matter its order on the answer line), the language other than English is populated.
- Population of the 4 home language questions is mandatory for all newly enrolling students including English-only students.

FOREIGN-BORN STUDENTS

For students born in foreign countries (does not include Puerto Rico or U.S. territories), two pieces of data are required for school sites to enter:

1. U.S. School Entry Date in the Language Assessment Page.

2. If a foreign-born student has been in U.S. schools < 3 years from U.S. school enter date, then SNOR field is set to "Y." If > than 3 years, it is set to "N."

The default is blank and should stay blank for students born in the U.S., born in U.S. territories/Puerto Rico, or are U.S. citizens born abroad.

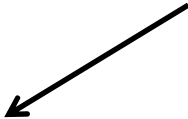


