RE: EC 49079-Safe School Act (SSA) (Notification to Teachers about Suspended Students)

Per Education Code EC §49079, the District shall inform the teacher of each pupil who has engaged in, or is reasonably suspected to have engaged in any of the acts described in any of the subdivisions, except subdivision (h), of Section 48900 or in Section 48900.2, 48900.3, 48900.4 or 48900.7 that the pupil engaged in, or is reasonably suspected to have engaged in, those acts. The information provided shall be from the previous three years.

The District's process for making this notification will change this school year. The SSA date field in the Aeries Discipline page will automatically populate when a student violates one of the SSA offenses and it is recorded in Aeries. This incident date will remain in the SSA date field for three years or until another SSA date, due to a new offense, is populated.

When one of these violations is noted in Aeries and an SSA date is populated, an asterisk will be generated in the teacher's attendance program (ABI). This will notify the teacher of each pupil who has engaged in, or is reasonably suspected of engaging in one of the acts listed above. If the teacher would like more information regarding the exact offense, s/he may review the student's cumulative file for the suspension notices and other records. As a reminder, the student's information is confidential and should not be shared with others.
